- ⦿ Grades determined via Self-Assessment rubric.
- ⦿ Self Assessment shared with public and approved by BOE.
- ⦿ Superintendent electronically certifies the Self Assessment and Statement of Assurances.
- ⦿ District grade = Average of the grades of each school .

  4. Curriculum and Instruction on HIB and Related Information and Skills
  5. HIB Personnel
  6. School- Level HIB incident Reporting Procedure
  7. HIB Investigation Procedure
  8. HIB Reporting

# RATING CATEGORIES

26 line items -Maximum 78 points

Does Not Meet the Requirements	0 Points
Partially Meets the Requirements	1 Point
Meets all Requirements	2 Points
Exceeds the Requirements	3 Points

\*Each Core Element receives score based on sum of ratings for all indicators within a core element.



# SUBMITTING THE DATA

- ⦿ Overall grade for each school will be reported as the sum of the subtotals of the 8 core elements compared to the sum of the maximum **score of 78**.
- ⦿ Principal submits all ratings and final score to NJDOE.
- ⦿ NJDOE calculates the average of total scores from all schools in district.
