- COVID-19 restrictions and increased security protocols were cited as the root cause in most responses.
- "Back-to-School Night" was held virtually in 21-22.


  As a result, many parents still have not seen inside their child's school/classroom.
- A noticeable drop off in parent involvement, guest speakers, volunteers were mentioned by parents and staff.
- Some instances of lack of communication, empathy, were also cited.

# After School Programs



- "More" after school clubs/activities requested
- Add more after-school academic help and tutoring
- Middle School clubs to have meetings more often
- O4 Add clubs for elementary students
- Multiple suggested programs were listed: Chess; Robotics; Surf, Fishing (Outdoors); Ski; STEM; Book/Reading; Baking/Cooking/Culinary

## College & Career Readiness



- Improved focus on career opportunities after graduation
- Financial Literacy (learning to balance checkbooks, how to use credit, etc.)
- Home economics and "basic life skills"
  Bring back "HS-101"
- Computer literacy skills and business etiquette (typing and email)
- More community based internships/apprenticeships

## Mental Health & Wellness




- Increased mental health support from counselors, including adding staff to support the need
- Adding mental health and behavior support at the elementary level
- lmprove anti-bullying policies and procedures
- Consideration and support of academic stressors
- Adding meditation, yoga, and other mental wellness opportunities to the curriculum or as an option for students during the school day

# Fine & Performing Arts



- Bring instrumental music, choir, and theater to lower elementary grades
- Add more opportunities for dance programs
- Expand theater program across multiple grade levels
- Increase opportunities for students to express themselves creatively

# Tutoring and Academic Support



- Expand current tutoring opportunities
- O2 Add more academic support in-class

Offer after-school academic help

Add additional supports for classified students, to include more time with support service providers

### Meal/Lunch Improvements



- O1 Provide healthier food options
- Improve the quality of food choices and meals served
- Add vegan/vegetarian, Halal/Kosher meal options for students and staff
- Improved consideration of individuals with food allergies (e.g. a "Gluten Free" zone)

# **Culturally Responsive**



- Expand "Noche Latina" program and add similar programs to other parent groups
- Expand social studies content to be more inclusive of other cultures/experiences
- Begin language education at the elementary level
- Add ASL and Mandarin as language electives at the High School
- Develop mentor program for students of color
